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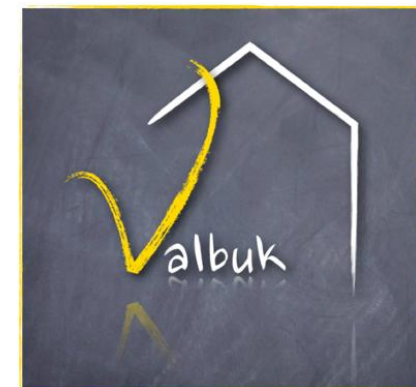

## THE AIMS OF THE PROJECT



Facilitate the **application of ECVET** by vet stakeholders, testing it in the cleaning sector.

Identify and test practical solutions to facilitate the development of **innovative practices in vet**, and their transfer.

Application of the **VQTS model**, successfully tested at the EU level, to analyze competences and their development in the cleaning sector in order to facilitate permeability and transfer of qualifications.

Test of a **qualification procedure**, including validation of competences acquired in non formal and informal contexts, for workers of the cleaning sector in order to recognize the prior learning.

Design and realize a **training model** ensuring the recognition of credits and partial qualifications.

- Comprehensive VQTS Matrix defining competences and steps of professional development in the cleaning sector.
